Dear Parents and Families,

We hope this message finds you doing well and that you are looking forward to spending time with your loved ones and friends over the holidays. We are excited that your student is interested in participating in the <u>Interfraternity Council's</u> (IFC) recruitment process at SMU and look forward to seeing them in a few weeks. This letter outlines important information about the formal process in which your student is registered to participate next month.

IFC is the governing council of ten fraternity chapters at SMU, many of which are affiliated with the <u>North-American Interfraternity Conference</u> (NIC). IFC as a collective body stands to promote the fraternal experience through inter-fraternal collaboration, personal and professional development, and the betterment of the community. Residential Commons will open on January 5, 2024, but students will not need to return to campus for IFC recruitment until **Friday, January 12th, 2024.** Students participating in IFC recruitment should communicate their return date with their residential commons.

For men registered to participate in recruitment, these dates are important: Saturday, January 13, 2024: Orientation & First Round Sunday, January 14-Friday, January 19th, 2024: Invitational Events Saturday, January 20, 2024: Bid Day

Eligibility Requirements

Students interested in joining one of our fraternities or sororities must meet the following eligibility requirements:

First-year students must have completed and passed at least 12 college credit hours in the previous semester to join (defined as fall or spring term); may have completed at a previous institution. Upper-class students must have a demonstrated ability to meet this requirement. Achieved a 2.5 GPA, cumulatively and in the previous semester.

Not be placed on conduct probation or higher with the Office of Student Conduct & Community Standards at any point in the current or previous semester to joining or

The recruitment process can be an exciting time. It can also be disappointing for some. Approximately 500 students participate in the IFC recruitment process at SMU, and about 80% will receive a formal bid to join a
